"THE PARADE STOPS HERE: HERALD SQUARE: Then & Now" *Bonnie's Lost NY Walks & Talks* (212-594-8039, lostnywalkstalks@verizon.net) Meet at the SE corner of Broadway & 42nd St (in front of the Gap) Closest subway: Times Square Q-N-R-S-1-2-3-7 **Tuesday 11/20 & 11/27 at 11am \$15 Following the Macy's parade route down Broadway from Times Square to Herald Square you will learn the history of the squares, the newspaperman who founded them and the wonderful buildings along the route. Find out about the mystery corner that should be part of the famous department store, who went down on the Titanic and why does Macys have a red star on their bags. See where Gimbels and B. Altman used to be and what is there now. And there's always The Empire State Building. (Approximately 2 hours)**

"HELL'S [KITCHEN]-A-POPPIN' ": Then & Now" *Bonnie's Lost NY Walks & Talks* (212-594-8039, lostnywalkstalks@verizon.net) Meet at the northwest corner of 59th and 9th Ave. Closest subway: Columbus Circle 59th St A-B-C-D-1. **Tuesday 12/4 at 11am \$15. From 59th to 39th where infamous tenements, triple murders, slaughterhouses and roaming gangs were commonplace. Home to one of the first apt buildings, fireproof tenements, old churches, breweries, the Hermitage and the Actor's Studio, Hell's kitchen has an exciting and colorful history just waiting to be explored. Join licensed guide Bonnie Young on a walk through Hell's Kitchen. (Approximately 2 hours long)**

"BETWEEN THE LIONS: Then & Now" *Bonnie's Lost NY Walks & Talks* (212-594-8039, lostnywalkstalks@verizon.net) Meet at the southeast corner of Broadway and 41st St. Closest subway Times Square Q-N-R-S-1-2-3-7. **Tuesday 12/11 at 11am \$15 Designated as public land in 1686, the area that is now home to the splendid New York Public Library and elegant Bryant Park has had an unbelievable history. Find out what was buried there long ago and what is buried there now, where American music history was made, and how all the buildings that surround this area have a history all their own. Ice-skating. Fashion shows and many other exciting stories. (Approximately 1-½ hours long)**

northeast corner of 44th St & 6th Ave. Closest subway: 42nd ST & 6TH Ave B-D-F-Q. Tuesday 12/18 at 11am \$15. Visit the haunts of Round Table writers and the infamous Belasco theatre. Hear about Olive Thomas, a Follies girl who haunts the New Amsterdam and Harry Houdini atop the Knickerbocker Hotel. Travel to the Landmark Tavern and hear about the ghost upstairs. Peek through the gate at Clinton Court. Find out about a cemetery that just disappeared and maybe, just maybe we will see Marilyn Monroe on the steps of the Actor's Studio. (Approximately 2 hours)
